AMERICA'S LARGEST ARTILLERY FIRING EXERCISE SINCE WORLD WAR TWO
IS UNDERWAY RIGHT NEXT DOOR IN THE DESERT OF UTAH, AND THE WYOMING
ARMY NATIONAL GUARD IS KNOCKING AT THE DOOR OF OPPORTUNITY BY TRAINING
WITH SEVENTEEN THOUSAND SOLDIERS FROM TWENTY THREE OTHER STATES. NEARLY
FIVE HUNDRED WYOMING ARMY NATIONAL GUARD SOLDIERS FROM THE ONE FIFTEENTH
FIELD ARTILLERY BRIGADE AND TEN TWENTY SECOND MEDICAL DETACHMENT BOTH
BASED IN CHEYENNE, AND THE FIRST BATTALION, FORTY NINTH FIELD ARTILLERY
WITH HEADQUARTERS IN SHERIDAN ARE AMONG THE NINETY ONE UNITS PARTICIPATING
IN THE EXERCISE. THE TRAINING IN UTAH WILL CONTINUE FOR THE WYOMING SOLDIERS
THROUGH THURSDAY WHEN THEY PACK UP THEIR EQUIPMENT AND BEGIN TO MOVE BACK
