CAMP GUERNSEY'S 50TH

PAST MEETS PRESENT WHEN SOLDIERS AND HORSES FROM THE ONE-HUNDRED-FIFTEENTH WYOMING CAVALRY REORGANIZED GREET WYOMING GOVERNOR MIKE SULLIVAN. FROM THE GUERNSEY AIRPORT THEY WILL ESCORT SULLIVAN AS COMMANDER IN CHIEF TO CAMP GUERNSEY'S FIFTIETH CELEBRATION THURSDAY, JUNE 16.

THE FESTIVITIES BEGIN AT NINE-FORTY-FIVE A-M IN FRONT OF THE POST HEADQUARTERS AND ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. CAMP GUERNSEY IS SITUATED DIRECTLY SOUTH OF THE TOWN GUERNSEY.

VISITORS SHOULD USE THE MAIN GATE TO ENTER CAMP GUERNSEY AND PARK THEIR VEHICLES SOUTH OF THE POST HEADQUARTERS BUILDING.

A TIME CAPSULE WILL BE DEDICATED AND ARMY GUARD EQUIPMENT WILL BE DISPLAYED.

THE WYOMING NATIONAL GUARD FIRST TRAINED AT GUERNSEY IN JUNE 1938 WHEN 700 WYOMING SOLDIERS, INCLUDING THE ONE-HUNDRED-FIFTEENTH CAVALRY REGIMENT, TOOK PART IN MANUEVERS.
